

2006-07 Stock Garden Tractor & Lawn Mower Pull

\$5.00 HOOK-UP FEE

This is a fun event & a demonstration of power. Don't take the demonstration so serious that it ruins your day or someone else's day. Unsportsman like conduct will not be tolerated.

1. Limit 2 pulls per tractor. Limit of 1 trophy per person.
2. Skid plates or wheelie bars **REQUIRED** on every tractor at a safe height..
3. May run any type of gas – **NO** alcohol. Factory type engine only, 4,000 RPM maximum.
4. 1- or 2-cylinder engines **ONLY**. 2-wheel drive tractors only.
5. Must have working governor – hand throttle **ONLY**, **NO** foot operated throttles.
6. Point of hook to be **NO** higher than 13 inches. Maximum hitch length 12 inches from center of axle.
7. No front wheels less than 6 inches, except lawn tractors with 8" rear tires.
8. **NO** tire chains, cut tires, or factory pulling tires.
9. Weights cannot extend more than 6 inches in front of front wheels, and no more than even with rear wheels.
10. Cannot move hydrostat or veri-drive after 30 feet. **Hands off after 30 feet, this includes throttle.**
11. **NO fast pulls**, pullers starting too fast will be stopped and must restart in lower gear from that point, if still too fast, they will be disqualified.
12. Tractors and sled must stay within the boundaries of the track during the pull. If not, measurement will be made from where tractor or sled first goes out of bounds.
13. The first puller in each class is the test puller and, if he wishes may re-pull in the last position in his class.
14. If two or more pullers go out the gate for a full pull, a pull off will be held after the last tractor in that class has pulled.
15. The pull will end when forward movement of the sled stops, or when the sled goes beyond the end of the track (i.e. out of the gate). **NO JERKING** of sled, **NO FORWARD** to **BACKWARD ROCKING**, **NO BOUNCING** on seat or you will be stopped and measured at that point.
16. **All children MUST** be able to steer tractors by themselves and keep both hands on the wheel at all times.
17. Driver will remain in the seat and keep at least 1 hand on the steering wheel at all times or will be disqualified.
18. If you are unable to finish you pull for mechanical reasons you may repull at the end of class, providing that the problem can be fixed.
19. All pullers must sign wavers.
20. Pullers **MUST** have tractors on track **1 hour BEFORE pull begins** to allow ample time for safety check and weigh-in for pull. There will be a **pullers meeting just prior** to start of pull.
21. Tractors must be weighed with wheelie bars and weight brackets attached.
22. Lawn mowers **MUST** have deck or belt removed.
23. Anything falling from tractor during pull, is a disqualification.
24. In case of rain once the pull has begun, only trophies will be given for classes that have been completed. All other trophies will be returned to the club.

Classes

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| | # drivers 100 pounds or less |
| Up to 600 pounds#* | tractor MUST have 8" rear wheels if driver weights over 100 pounds |
| 601-700 pounds* | |
| 701-800 pounds* | * up to and including 12" rims and 23" height |
| 801-900 pounds* | NO 12" wide tires, with exception of 6" duals allowed |
| 901-1000 pounds* | No aluminum wheels, steel wheels only |
